



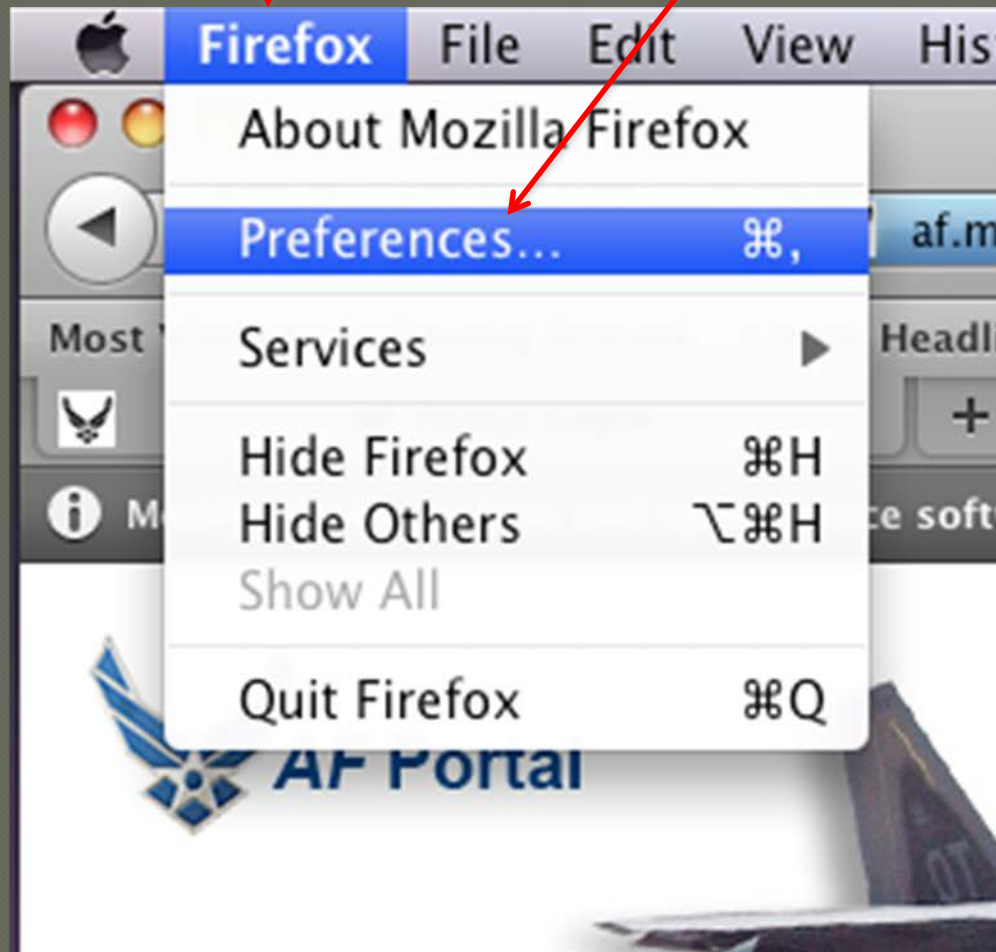
# How to Configure Firefox for CAC use on an Apple Computer

Please follow <http://militarycac.com/macnotes.htm> to first set up CAC use on your Mac. You'll need to download and install CACkey when deciding which CAC enabler to use.

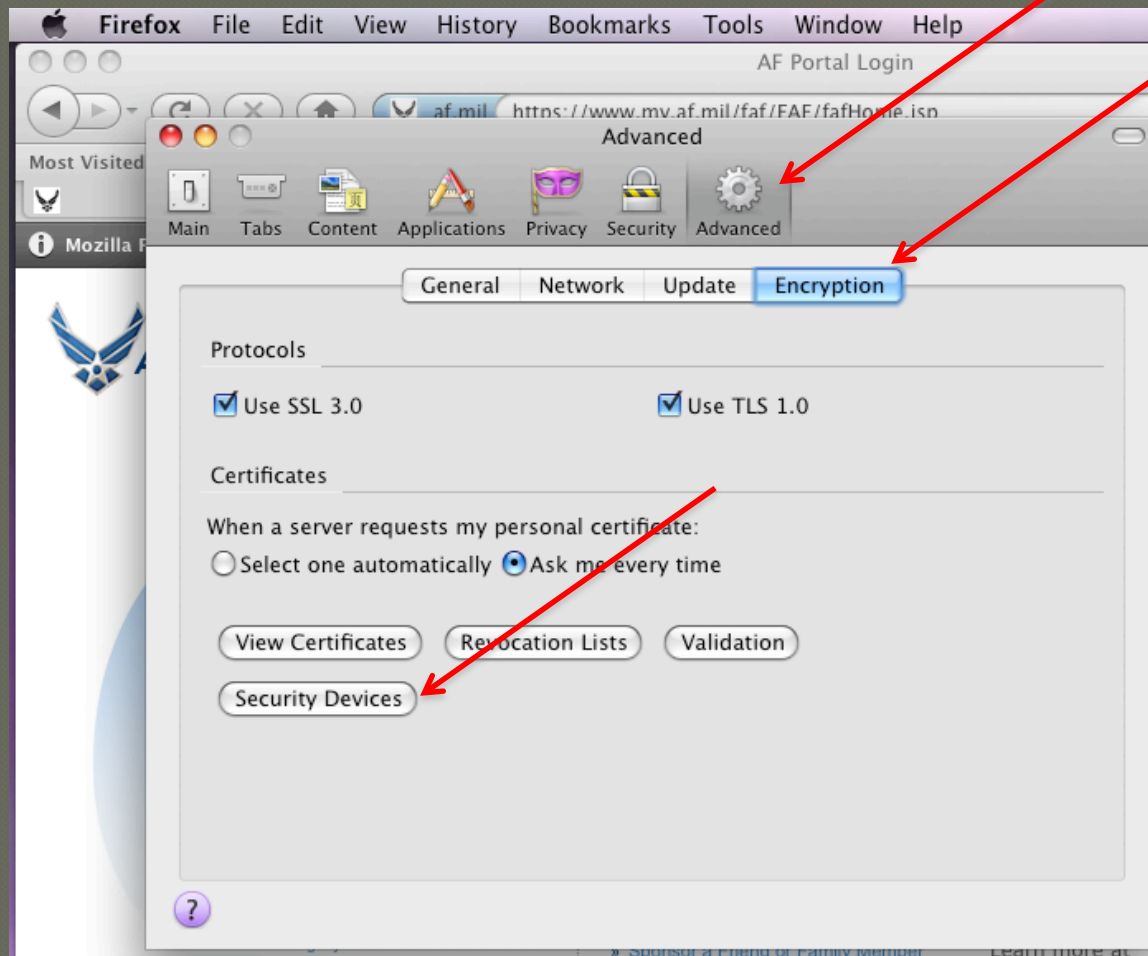

After you have installed CACkey...

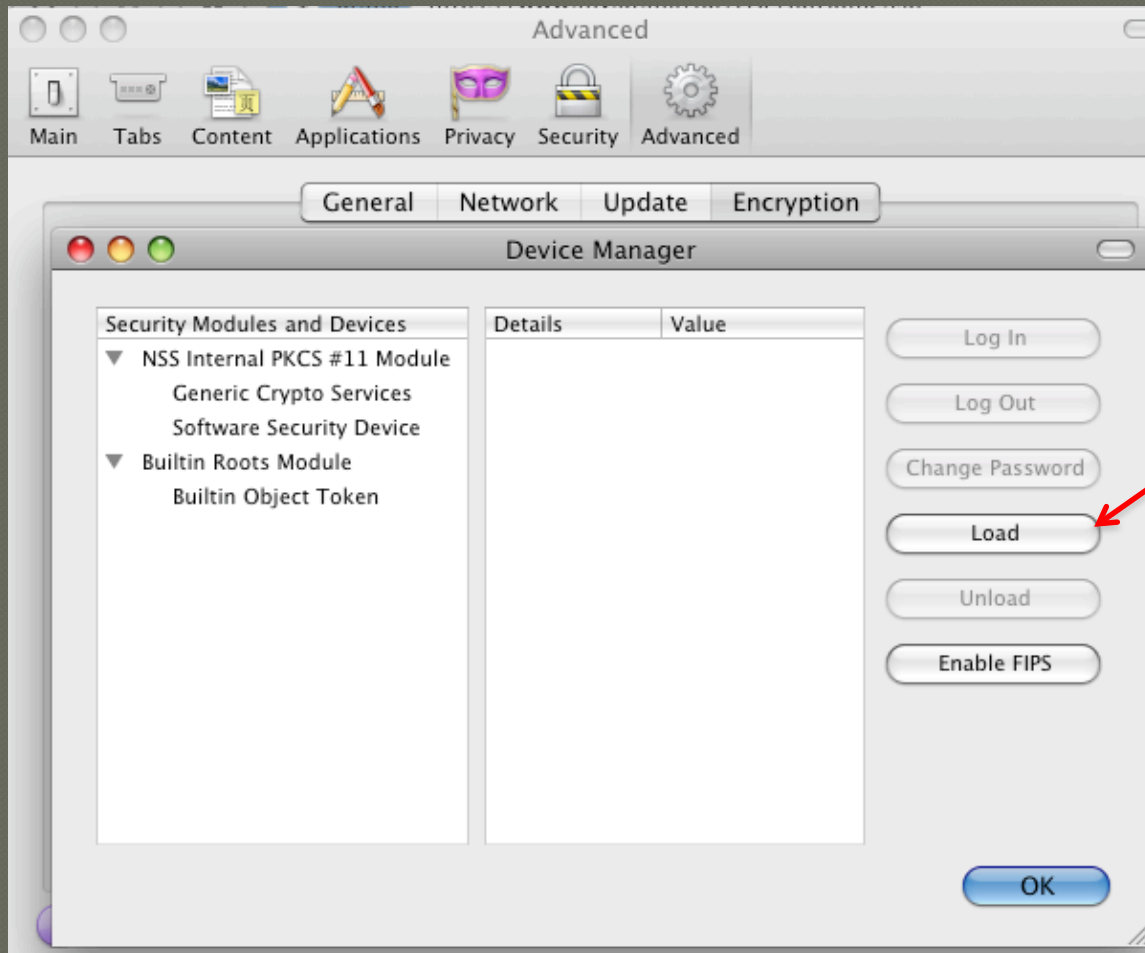
Click *Firefox, Preferences...*



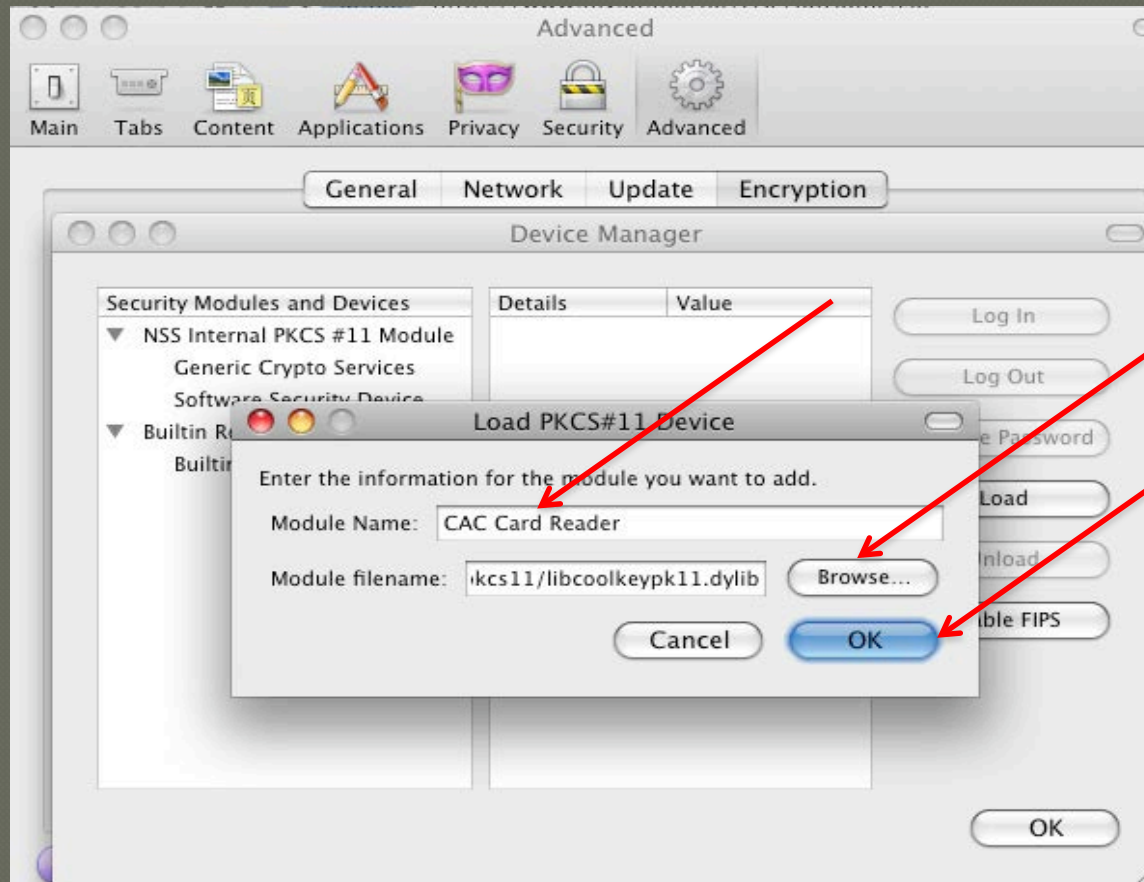
Click *Advanced*(gear), *Encryption*(tab), *Security Devices*(button)



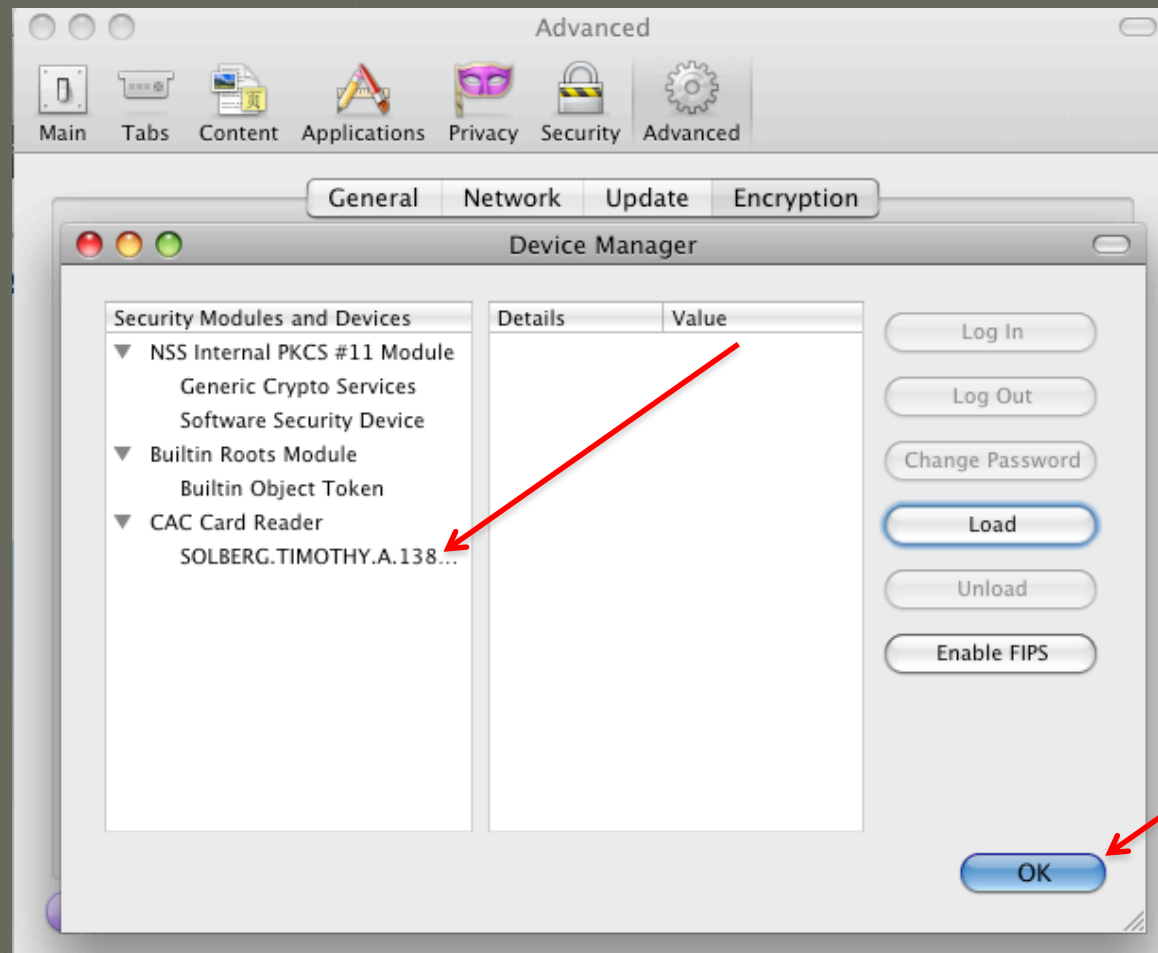
Click *Load*(button)



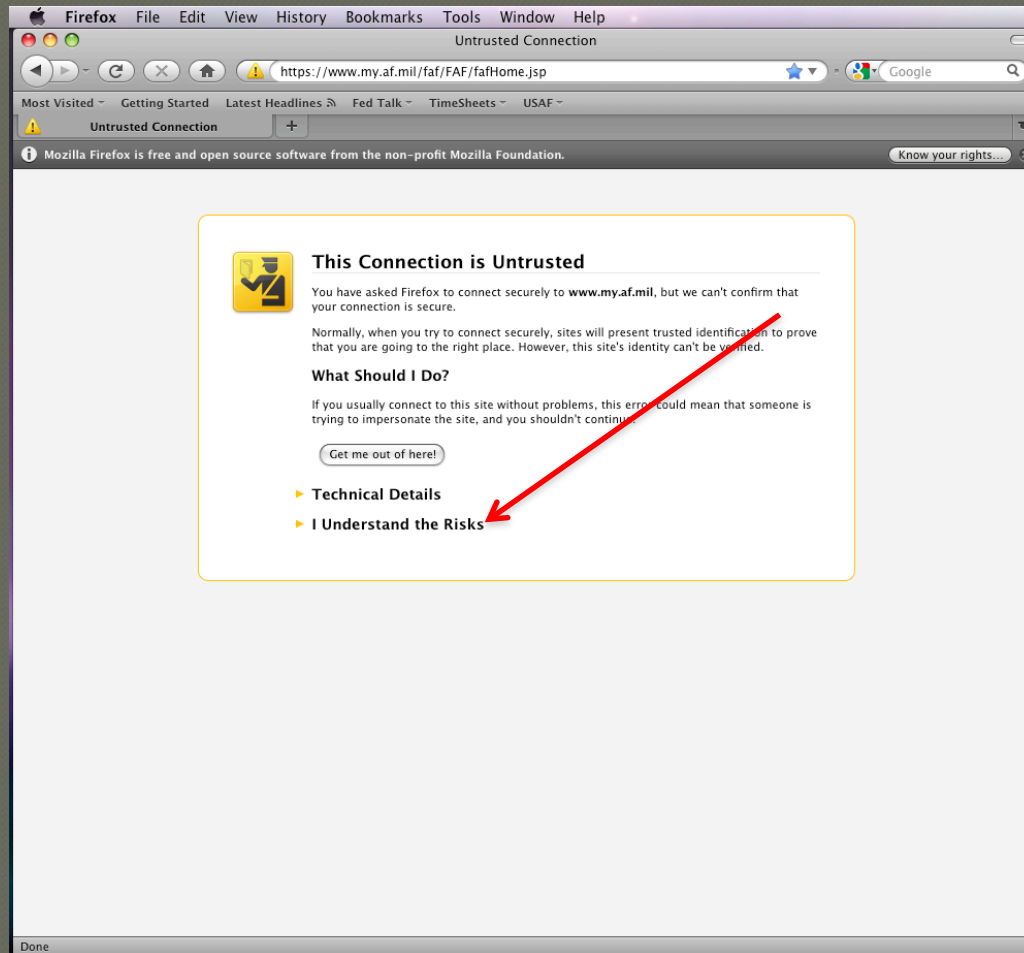
Type a name like: *CAC Reader* Browse to:  
your hard disk/library/CACKey/libcackey\_g.dylib  
then click *OK*



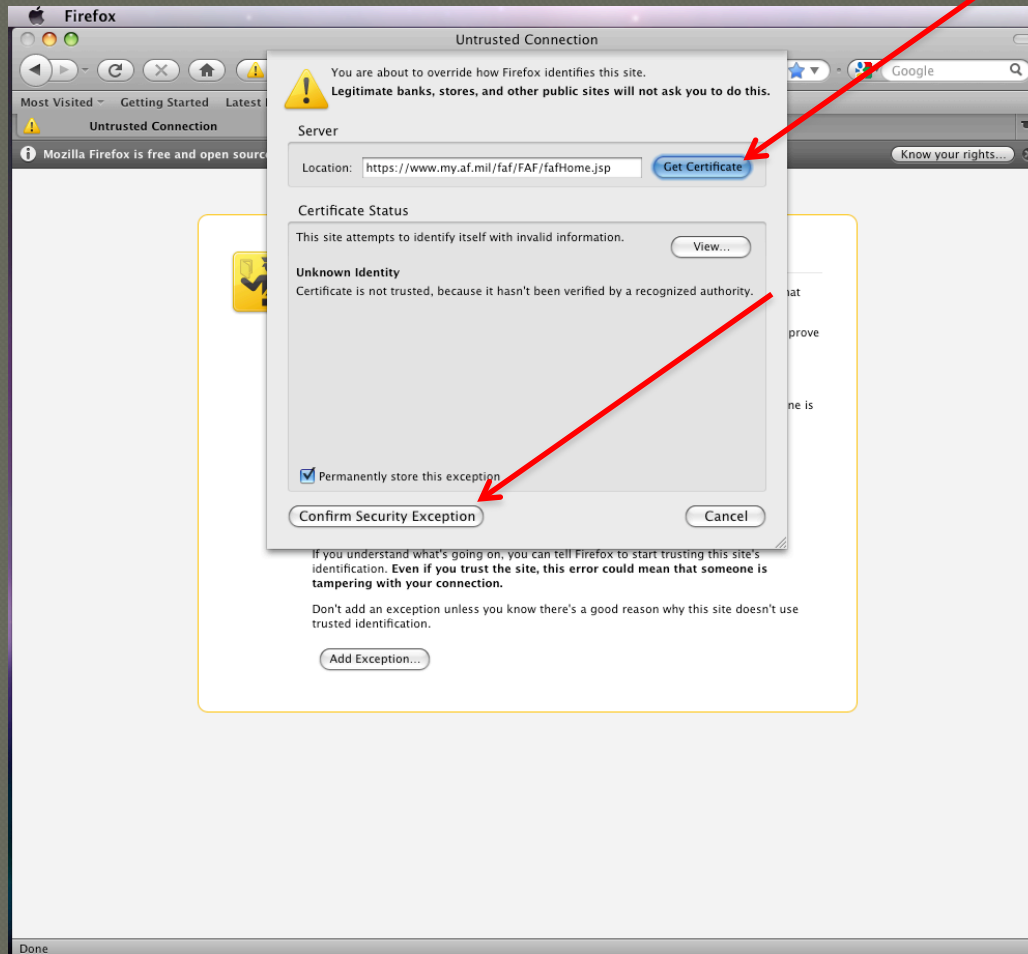
Below *Security Modules and Devices* you will see *CAC Reader* with your name below it. This means it worked, Click OK



Try going to a CAC enabled website via Firefox.
